Marwan uses some of Jean-Michel Basquiat's familiar characters executed

in simple yet bold brush strokes to get the audience's attention. The naive characters as well as the large format are a foolproof way that Marwan ensures that people heed his message.

Using quotes about the various meanings of LOVE throughout the ages by a group of eclectic authors, Marwan reiterates his message. The antidote to the dire state of the world is more LOVE and only more LOVE.
